Brent extended a Thank You to the Optimist Club Membership for their continued support and for having attended the Badger Camp 1966 Event on December 9. He stated the event was once again very successful, allowing Wisconsin Badger Camp to continue serving youth and adults with disabilities.





Brent summarized his history with Wisconsin Badger Camp. He worked parttime at Wisconsin Badger Camp, returning to Ohio off season. He relocated to Wisconsin from Ohio in 1987, at which time he was hired into a position as Camp Director. In 2002, Brent assumed responsibilities as Executive Director. In addition to himself, WI Badger Camp has 6 full-time staff members. During camp season, there are some 65 seasonal staff, many being international, nurses, dietician, head cook, etc.

Brent stated camp runs from June through August and serves approximately 900 individuals, approximately 106/week. There is one week for youth, one week for teens and 8 weeks for adults. Of those attending camp, the repeat percentage is 80%+. In addition to local campers, individuals come from Green Bay, Eau Claire, La Crosse and 6 other states.

There is always a 'wish list' for improvements and most recently, they converted

to online application from paper. The next item on the 'wish list' is to improve/enlarge the health center. To support funding for improvements, they are hoping to reach out further into the state in addition to hosting another event during the spring/summer. Time was allowed for questions and answers. It is always a pleasure to have a return visit from Brent and hear about the wonderful things they do at Wisconsin Badger Camp.
