Program: Ken Kamps coordinated our speaker for today, Sigwarth, noting he really needed no formal introduction. It is always a pleasure hearing from one of our members, and as a Friend of Optimist, we were excited for Tom's presentation today.

You might say Tom is a bit of a Historian, as he has an avocation for researching historical facts on various subjects. Tom was with us today to share his historical findings about Platteville.

His research started by studying street names in the City, such as Ellen Street, Laura Street and Cora Street. Founding Father, John Hawkins Rountree names Laura Street after his first wife while his daughters were Ellen and Cora. John's later married Lydia Southworth, thus the name of Lydia Street. We also have Harrison Street, names after John's son, Harrison. Virgin Avenue came about through his partner, Noah Virgin.





Tom also referenced several buildings in Platteville. First English Lutheran Church was originally First Lutheran Church of Peace, which was of German background with services done in German. At the turn of the century, it was renamed FELC and became an English speaking gathering. Free Methodist Church, which also housed several other worship entities, is now Blue Notes. The original UWP Academy is now situated on the corner of Bonson and Cedar and at Lancaster and Adams, sits the original student center structure.

It is obvious Platteville has many streets with curves and corners, which is directly related to the Mine Shafts during the prominent mining era.

Much more was shared and the members enjoyed the question and answer time following the presentation. It is a pleasure holding our meetings at Tom's place of business and was delightful to have him

and his wife, Renee, join us this morning.
