Tammy described the efforts to revitalize the downtown with the arrival of the big box stores. Since the downtown is the focal point of the community, it is important to keep the store fronts occupied and vibrant. This takes time as the Main Street Program is comprised of volunteers and a public private partnership.

The Main Street Program has components to ensure that the businesses on Main Street can flourish.

- ✓ Design which works with the building owners to ensure that they have the resources necessary to be successful. One of the ways to do this is arranging clean up days with the high school students.
- ✓ Promotion which draws people to Main Street including Activities like Music in the Park, Sweet Treats on Main, Historic Walk Down Main and Monthly Mingle.
- ✓ Vitality which draws businesses to the downtown and helps keep them there.
 Connect businesses with economic opportunities to apply for grants and
 various ways to grow their businesses.
- ✓ Organization which works with planning and economic development for Main Street.
- ✓ Sustainability has added recycling bins to City Park and the garden space by Genoa Towers.
- ✓ Sponsorship to help businesses obtain their 501(c)(3) status for grants.

Overall goal is to restore Main Street to what it looked like before. July 17th Southwest Car Club was going to display their cars on Main Street for the day.
