Finance/Administrative:

<u>Financial Report:</u> Asst. Treasurer, John Urness updated the membership with balance information in both the internal account and the youth account. He identified upcoming activity in both accounts that will significantly reduce current balances; however is expected per the 2016-2017 budget. * Gary Munson updated the membership on the status of the Essay Contest. Entry deadline was February 1 and we received 39 entries, up from 30 in 2016. All entries came from the Platteville Middle School Eighth Grade. Four additional awards will be given this year in the amount of \$25.00 each in addition to the two first place at \$100 each and 2 second place of \$50 each with \$150.00 coming from the Noon Club and \$150.00 from the Morning Club. The extra \$100 will come from the Morning Club budget, which is already accounted for. Ten schools are contacted and following discussion, it was agreed contact another year should be made directly with the eighth grade instructor(s) versus sending to administrative offices.

The Committee Chairman is currently unable to accept such a task, thus this will be researched at a later date.

~ Maxine stated we should start thinking about a Second Vice President and Foundation Representative.


~ Gary Engelke shared information on ordering Optimist International shirts, one of which he was wearing. Contact information is attached. 10% of sales go back to Optimists.
