Program:

Our speaker was Kathy Hottenstein from Family Advocates. Kathy enlightened us on the existence of violence and sexual abuse. There is a real need to expand the reporting of such incidents. She talked about abusers and their victims. In many cases the victim returns to the abuser and it is always a different situation as to why this may happen. Family Advocates cannot supply legal assistance, but when and where needed, they are able to help with direction, resources, forms and court appearances. Kathy also talked about the need for funding, where funding typically comes from, and what it is used for by the organization. Any help they receive financially is greatly appreciated. A Q&A session followed with many members adding to the discussion
